Purpose:

Face-to-face sessions are back. COVID Safe Policy outlines some important regulations and guidelines that must be followed to keep everyone safe and comply with government directions.

COVID SAFE RULES – HOME AND OTHER VISITS

- Adults are required to exercise social distancing (1.5m) and adhere to the density limit.
- Adults and children are required to wash or sanitize their hands at the start of the session.
- Adults are required to wear a face mask.
- Staff will wear a face mask.
- Staff will wash/sanitise their hands before and after each session. Staff are equipped with water, soap and sanitiser in their vehicles.
- Staff will practice social distancing during the session (1.5 metres). We will try to position ourselves next to you and your child instead of being opposite you.
- Blossom Therapy Services will maintain a high level of cleanliness and hygiene.
- Our staff are regularly cleaning equipment and toys.
- If anyone in your household is showing any signs or symptoms of COVID-19, waiting for a COVID-19 test result or has been instructed to self-isolate, please contact us immediately.

COVID SAFE RULES – GALADA COMMUNITY CENTRE

- Any parent/guardian entering the building must sign in using the QR code.
- Masks must be worn inside the premises by all aged 12 and above.
- Any person entering the building must use hand sanitiser/wash hands upon arrival.
- Clients should not arrive more than 5-10 minutes early for their sessions and should leave on time at the end of their session.
- Consumption of food and drink is to be avoided in the clinic room.
- Our staff are regularly cleaning equipment, toys, benches, and door handles. Council has organised regularly cleaning of common areas.
- Limit your movement to the allocated room
- If anyone in your household is showing any signs or symptoms of COVID-19, waiting for a COVID-19 test result or has been instructed to self-isolate, please contact us immediately.

WHAT HAPPENS IF SOMEONE AT BLOSSOM THERAPY CONTRACTS COVID 19?

- We will follow directions from health authorities and face-to-face sessions are likely to be suspended.
- If possible and appropriate, telehealth sessions will be provided.
- Galada Community Centre will be advised so they can take appropriate actions.

- Parents will be contacted to raise awareness of the situation and to ensure that those affected can seek medical advice.
- We will follow the guidance from the health authorities and keep all families informed.
